



On May 26, 2017 the first in the history of the revived School of Medicine of V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University **student scientific-practical conference on microbiology "Prospects and modern tendencies of development of modern virology"** will be held. The conference will be held for the first time; however, we hope that it will become a traditional and annual event at the School of Medicine of V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University and will promote the popularization of the discipline "Microbiology, Virology and Immunology" among students and its in-depth study. **The organizer** of the conference is the Department of General and Clinical Immunology and Allergology of the School of Medicine; **Moderators of the conference** - instructors of microbiology, virology and immunology: the Candidate of Biology, associate professor S. H. Malanchuk (for students of the English- language form of education) and the Candidate of Medicine, associate professor O. P. Kozlov (for students of the Ukrainian-language form of education).

The conference will present the reports of students on the most acute and topical issues of modern virology. In the course of preparation students will receive in-depth knowledge on the subject of the report and develop the mastery of preparing a poster report.

The conference will be held in **two stages**. **On the first stage** it will be the remote assessment of poster reports on a number of parameters (the evaluation scheme is attached) by the jury members (list of members of the jury of the remote stage of the conference is attached). All posters will be posted in the electronic repository of the University. Based on the voting results of the jury, the best 15 posters will be selected, which will be presented during **the second stage** of the conference. The best speakers and authors of posters will be awarded with diplomas and certificates.

The Dean of the School of Medicine, Doctor of Medicine, full professor **I. V. Belozarov** and the Head of the Department of General and Clinical Immunology and Allergology, Director of State Organization "Mechnikov Institute of Microbiology and Immunology of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine", Doctor of Medicine, full professor **M. M. Popov**.

On **May 26, 2017 at 15.15** the second stage of the conference will be held in the auditorium **№580** of the Northern Building of V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University. **The working languages** of the conference are Ukrainian, English and Russian.

## **Participation in the conference**

Students of all courses of the School of Medicine of V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University are invited to take part in the first student scientific-practical conference "Prospects and modern tendencies of development of modern virology".

To participate in the first stage of the conference (remote assessment of poster reports), please send poster reports **in .ppt or .pptx format** (Microsoft Office Power Point file) on the chosen theme, concerning clinical virology, to e-mail boxes of conference moderators until **May 20, 2017** (English-language poster reports - the Candidate of Biology, associate professor S. H. Malanchuk, [s.malanchuk@karazin.ua](mailto:s.malanchuk@karazin.ua); Russian- and Ukrainian-language poster reports - the Candidate of Medicine, associate professor O. P. Kozlov, [kozlov@karazin.ua](mailto:kozlov@karazin.ua)).

**The recommended size** of the poster report is 15-25 slides. **Languages of posters** are Ukrainian, English and Russian. On the first slide of the report the participant's name (in full) and the academic group **must be indicated**.

The results of remote assessment of the poster reports of the conference participants will be published on **May 22, 2017** in the "News" section of the official website of the School of Medicine (<http://medicine.karazin.ua>). The authors of the **best 15 poster reports** on the results of the ranking will be invited to participate in the second stage of the conference, which will be held on **May 26, 2017 at 15.15** in the auditorium **№580** of the Northern Building of the University.

**The scheduled time** for the report during the second stage of the conference is 10 minutes. **Languages of reports** - Ukrainian, English, Russian.

### **Criteria for remote assessment of poster reports during the first stage of the conference:**

- ⇒ Completeness of consideration of a problem issue (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Relevance of the data given (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Structure of the material (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Using of diagrams, drawings, schemes, video materials, etc. (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Quality of the poster report (0-10 points)

**The maximum score is 50 points.** Assessment is carried out simultaneously and independently by all the members of the jury, after which for each participant of the remote stage of the conference the final average mark is calculated, by the value of which the ranking of participants of the conference is conducted. The **top 15 poster reports** on the results of the ranking are selected for the second stage of the conference.

### **Criteria for assessment of poster reports during the second stage of the conference:**

- ⇒ Completeness of consideration of a problem issue (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Relevance of the data given (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Structure of the material (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Using of diagrams, drawings, schemes, video materials, etc. (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Quality of the poster report (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Quality of the oral report (0-10 points)
- ⇒ Level of ownership of the material according to the answers to the questions of the jury members (0-10 points)

**The maximum score is 70 points.** Assessment is carried out simultaneously and independently by the members of the jury, after which the final score of each participant is counted. According to the results of the ranking of participants on the average score, the **winners of the conference** are determined.
